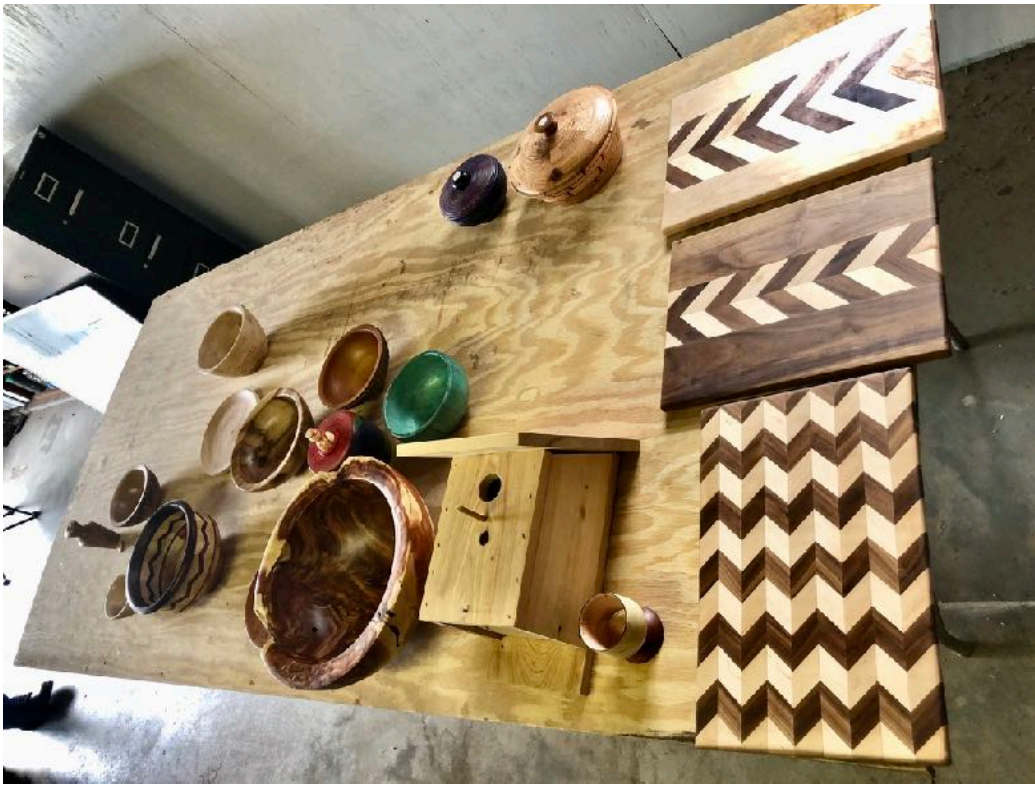

Show and tell





- Beads of Courage children receive Beads for every procedure they go thru. It is desirable for our boxes to hold them all. As a result, turned or rectangular lidded boxes need to be large. Larger is better!
- Recommended **interior** dimensions for turned boxes are: 6" diameter (5" min.), 5" height (4" min.).
- Recommended **interior** dimensions for flatwork boxes are 4"x6"x4"
- Box bases should be wide enough so the box is stable and does not tip over easily. Lids for Beads of Courage boxes should be easy for small or ill children to remove or lift. Any finials should be easy for a small child to grasp and not too elaborate so they don't break.
- Finishing of boxes is extremely important! Beads of Courage children who receive these boxes are susceptible to germs/ infections/mold. Bowls that have not been properly sealed can harbor mold. Please take the time to ensure you are using a safe finishing process that does not contain toxic materials. No linseed oil.
- All kinds of wood are beautiful! Please **refrain from painting** Beads of Courage boxes. Instead, highlight the beauty of the wood with clear varnish, a stain, and/or burning.

Lets have some samples for the next meeting. I can store them here in my shop. **Beads sizes 13/16" dia and 1/4 thick. Pick up beads at next meet or stop by the house 585 317 7973**



Goodyear Show Sept 1-30 2022

First off Goodyear has a gallery section and a shop section. In a gallery you are not restricted to 10 items but in shop you are.

**Cost to show at Goodyear.**

(JIAA) Jekyll Island Arts Asso.

- Cost for one year is \$ 30.00 Joining Before MARCH 31ST entitles you to 10 pcs to show year round. Year ends March 31 2023.
- Join on August 1st and have approx. 7 months to show and sell till March 31. Same cost \$ 30.00 entitles you to 10 pcs to show.
- Cost to not join and just show for September \$ 30.00 a one time exhibitors fee,
- Your fee entitles you to advertising, setting up and display of art and a check at end of month for items sold.
- The show shall be restricted to 50 items.
- Cost to you for items sold is 25%  
Sample for pricing:: Let's say you have a bowl you think is worth \$ 50.00. Mark it up 35%= \$67 .50 , they will charge 25% which leaves you with 50.63.
- They want pcs priced in even numbers **no cents**
- IF you have a piece you do not want to sell mark it high. Can not mark NOT FOR SALE IN OUR GALLERY OPENING.
